#### Officers

#### President

The President is charged with overseeing all phases of the club's activities, other officers' conduct and administration of their duties, chairpersons' conduct and administration of their chairs, and any club committees they may be in charge of.

While it is the duty of each board member to inform the president of any and all activities pertaining to the club, good or bad, the President is responsible for each board member maintaining their position in the best way they are capable.

The President should attend committee and social functions as often as possible, or in his absence, direct the Vice-President to attend.

The President is to lead regular and board meetings in discussions and conduct business in an orderly manner. He/she must also strive to bring the club, as a whole, into the mainstream of club activities and continue CSC as an effective organization

Specific duties are to include, but are not limited to:

- Insure a meeting place is available and unlock such meeting place as necessary.
- 2. Keep the club banner, bring it to regular meetings and display same.
- Coordinate closely with Secretary on club correspondence and is responsible for contents of same.
- Is the official CSC representative in all matters, legal and otherwise, and shall sign all contracts and agreements that bind CSC.
- Sign checks as needed when the Treasurer is unavailable.
- 6. Is in charge of planning the Annual Awards Banquet.
- Submits an article for each issue of the Newsletter.
- Host one (1) board meeting per year and obtain business meeting raffle prizes for that month. (Is reimbursed for raffle prizes up to the limit established by the board.)
- Prepare an estimated budget for this position and submit it to the board at the February and October board meeting.
- 10. Maintain a permanent file of meeting minutes provided by the Secretary.
- Follow attached outline as closely as possible at regular meetings and board meetings, referring to meeting minutes of previous meetings for Agenda.
- Assigns two board members to verify all club assets at the January board meeting.
   (Treasurer must bring all monies, check book and other documents necessary to complete the audit.) The two board members will verify funds and sign Audit Report.
- Establish committees as required.
- 14. Is a member of all standing and ad-hoc committees.
- Hand out a membership application and answer questions about the club when an opportunity presents itself.



Then, with about 20 minutes to go, a couple of GTP drivers, vying for the lead, got overly aggressive (meaning stupid) and caused a huge pile-up that forced the Corvette off the track to avoid them. Antonio Garcia did a good job bringing the Corvette to the finish in 5<sup>th</sup> place. Next stop is Long Beach.







#### Chevrolet Has Zero Allocations for Z06 Nationwide

Today was supposed to be the start of another Z06 order cycle, and we know that dealers were anticipating something following the recent memo about the final customer orders for the Z06 need to be <u>submitted by April 5th</u>. But unfortunately, it's the same bad news as last month...zero allocations nationwide.

We don't know what's going on with the car, and our friends at various dealers don't know what is going on either. But we do know these two things, first is that Chevrolet announced a hard deadline for customer sold orders to be in by April 5th, and there is just one more Thursday (March 30th) that appears on the calendar before that deadline.

So, Keith...are you saying there is still a chance?

Yes, we suppose there could be allocations that drop next Thursday, and dealers would have until that following Tuesday, April 4th at 11:59 PM to finalize those customer sold orders. I guess anything is possible at this point. But the reality is that we are one week away from knowing whether or not there will any more customer Z06 orders submitted for the 2023 model year.

It must be extraordinarily difficult to be a Corvette seller in this environment, with customers beating down your door to hand over money for a car that can't be ordered. Just keep that in mind when you're calling your dealer that they are in the dark like the rest of us.

GM has left the door open to further allocations by telling dealers that they retain the ability to submit Dealer Stock Orders after the April 5th deadline, and we know many dealers that would love to get their hands on a Dealer Stock Order because then it can be sold in a manner that benefits them the most.
