#### **RED BOOK**

#### **OFFICER AND CHAIR RESPONSBILITIES**

#### Secretary

The Secretary acts as the club's "scribe" and is responsible directly to the President, and for aiding the President in club correspondence.

Specific duties are to include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Take minutes at all General Member and Board Meetings, type them and email a copy to all board members within one week after that meeting. Have copy of General Member Meeting Minutes available at next General Member Meeting after approval as corrected.
- 2. Maintain a permanent file of past and current meeting minutes on CSC's Google drive.
- 3. Prepare board meeting notifications and email 8-10 days in advance of the board meeting to all board members and the prospective members who are required to attend in order to fulfill last requirement for full membership.
- 4. Maintain the club P.O. Box, pick up mail once a week, and distribute it to the appropriate board member(s).
- 5. Prepare the club's Statement of Information—Domestic Nonprofit Corporation form (SI-100), and send (can be filed online, go to <a href="www.sos.ca.gov">www.sos.ca.gov</a>) to Secretary of State, Sacramento, with appropriate filing fee. Due in November of odd years.
- 6. Inform membership of any special vote coming up, i.e.; bylaw changes, vacant board positions, etc.
- 7. Update the club bylaws, rules and guidelines, after vote of approval by the membership.
- 8. Type and mail membership card to each member in good standing (has paid next year's dues) in accordance with updated roster received from the Membership Chairperson to be mailed with the election ballots.
- 9. Provide box for drawing name of Election Committee volunteers at the October regular meeting, and for deposit of completed nomination forms at the November regular meeting.
- 10. Email on November 1st to each member a board position nomination form for each member to fill in and return to the Secretary.
- 11. Email nomination notifications to each member nominated for a board position
- 12. Prepare and provide to the Election Committee at the December regular meeting the following materials: Election Committee Responsibilities, Official Ballots, List of Eligible Voting Members, Letter of Instruction to Voting members and addressed and stamped envelopes.
- 13. Host one (1) board meeting per year and obtain general meeting raffle prizes for that month. (Is reimbursed for raffle prizes up to the limit established by the board.)
- 14. Prepare an estimated budget for this position and submit it to the board at the March and October board meeting.
- 15. Hand out membership applications and answer questions about the club when an opportunity presents itself.

#### **National Corvette Museum New Display**



Corvette celebrates 70 years with a new museum display.

The Corvette and many of its devoted fans partied Thursday night like it was 1953, the year GM introduced the iconic sports car.

Nearly 300 people crowded into the Skydome of the National Corvette Museum, which used the birthday bash to kick off its new "An American Love Affair" exhibit that celebrates the car's seven decades.

Held the evening before the 70th anniversary of the day the first Corvette rolled off the assembly line in Flint, Mich., the celebration showcased a collection of some five dozen vintage Corvettes that trace the evolution of the sports car from that 1953 model to the brand-new hybrid E-Ray that goes into production later this year.

The theme is accentuated in the eight-minute video displayed on the new \$800,000 "Skywall" wrap-around video screen in the museum's Skydome.

"When we started talking about what we could do to celebrate the 70th anniversary of this amazing car, we wanted to not just tell the history but pull something together that would resonate with everyone," said Sharon Brawner, the museum's president and CEO. "We realized that this car has permeated popular culture in movies, TV shows, songs, and toys for years.
