

National Corvette Museum Events:

The Michelin Bash is (was) April 27-29 at the Museum. We have several CSC members who will be in attendance, and next month I will report on how it went.

Corvette Racing:

April 15 was IMSA racing at Long Beach. The #3 Corvette C8.R finished 2nd in class. It was a clean race and Jordan Taylor did a great job in the last stint getting around the #9 Porsche to get second place points. After three races, the driver team of Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor is in third place in season point. Next up is WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca in May. We were told, during a Corvette Racing presentation at the Corvette Corral at Long Beach, that next year Corvette plans to run two of the new C8.R Z06 GT3 cars in IMSA GTD Pro, and two in GTD Am.

Sunday, April 16, was WEC racing at Portimão, Portugal. It was a 6-hour race, and Nicky Catsburg showed his skill and experience in the last stint to hold off a Ferrari and take the win-in-class for Corvette Racing. That Corvette driver team has a big season-points lead going into the next race of the season, a 6-hour race at Spa-Francorchamps in May. That will be followed by Le Mans in June.

800-HP Twin-Turbo ZR-1 And 1000-HP Zora Hybrid

Based on the May 2023 Issue of Car and Driver, the C8 ZR-1 and the C8 Zora are in the works. The ZR-1 is expected to be a twin-turbo version of its screaming flatplane-crank V-8 currently in the Z06. The Zora will take it one step further and add in the E-Ray's electrification!

It is estimated that the ZR-1 will have 800-HP driving the rear wheels and the Zora will have 1,000-HP and AWD.

The untold story of the C8 was to ultimately go for the throat of Lamborghinis, McLarens, or anything with the word "hypercar" or "exotic" in its dating profile. Those whispers will become a reality in the next couple of years with the arrival of two ultra-high-performance Corvettes: the ZR-1 and the Zora.

The ZR-1 is rumored to be released in 2025 with the Zora coming sometimes afterwards. Both the ZR-1 and the Zora are expected to incorporate active aerodynamic elements, such as a rear wing and a front splitter, and offer a Z07-style track package. Though the ZR-1's weight will presumably rise by about 200 pounds over a Z06 due to its new turbo componentry and greater powertrain-cooling requirements, it will be the quickest Corvette around a racetrack while remaining as comfortable on the street as a Z06. Its performance will put it in contention with everything from the McLaren 750S to the Porsche 911 Turbo S. But its base price is estimated to be around \$150,000 and will severely undercut competitors by tens or even hundreds of thousands. The hypercar Zora is estimated to flirt with a starting price of around \$200,000, or about \$140,000 less than a McLaren 750S.
